

Moving to Alberta?

Here is what you need to have from your existing *Province or Country* to get your Alberta Insurance.

Before you move to Alberta:

1. **Drivers Abstract** for the last 3 years for all drivers on vehicles. (Your driving record of speeding tickets, convictions and suspensions).
2. **Insurance History** (Claims Experience Letter) for all drivers on vehicle(s) from current insurance company and any records available since you started driving.
3. **Copy of current Drivers Licence** for all drivers. If moving to Alberta permanently you will be required to change to an Alberta Licence. If move is temporary you can drive with your current Provincial or License of Country.
4. **Copy of Current Insurance Policy** (if available)

After you move to Alberta:

1. For vehicles brought into Alberta - Registries will require an “**Out of Province Safety Inspection**”.
2. For vehicles purchased in Alberta that are older than 15 years will require a “**Motor Vehicle Inspection Report**”.
3. **Bank Account in Canada** if you would like to have a payment plan.
Copy of Bank withdrawal form or void cheque.
4. Alberta Registries will require proof of Insurance and residency before you can register any vehicle in Alberta.
